

Range Safety Officer Course

There will be a NRA Range Safety Officer course on January 30, 2010. The course will be for club members only; the cost will be \$35. This includes books and other materials needed for the class. There will also be a processing fee to NRA of \$20 for NRA members and \$25 for non-NRA members as well as a certification fee to NRA of \$6 for NRA members and \$11 for non-NRA members. There is a limit of 20 students for this class. If there is enough interest there will be another class in the spring. This is the NRA Certified RSO course that allows club members to bring up to five guests and participate in club functions as an RSO. This certification is recognized nationwide, not just at the club facilities.

What is an NRA Range Safety Officer?

The NRA Range Safety Officer program was developed in response to the demand for a nationally-recognized range safety officer certification. NRA Range Safety Officers are people who possess the knowledge, skills, and attitude essential to organizing, conducting, and supervising safe shooting activities and range operations.

NRA Range Safety Officers must be 21 years of age or older.

The Range Safety Officer course consists of: Range Safety Officer's roles and responsibilities, range standard operating procedures, range inspection and range rules, firearm stoppages and malfunctions, and Range Safety Briefings which include emergency procedures.

Candidates must also receive 90 percent or better on the written exam.
