

North Carolina Concealed Carry Handgun Training

Course Goal

To teach the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude necessary for safely carrying a concealed handgun.

Course Lessons

1. Legal Issues
2. Handgun Safety
3. Handguns
4. Marksmanship Fundamentals
5. Carrying Concealed Safety Issues
6. Presentation Techniques
7. Cleaning and Maintenance
8. Ammunition
9. Proficiency Drills

Additional content will include:

- proper carrying, cleaning and storage of pistols relative to the environment
- pistol selection (based on student requirements)
- ammunition selection and care
- other pertinent subjects based upon student questions

Course Length:

This is a full day course – approximately 10 hours.

(This includes all classroom and range time. Depending upon the number of students and their abilities, the course length may vary.)

Course Cost:

The fee for this course is currently \$100.⁰⁰

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisites for taking this course. Proficiency with a handgun is important as a qualification course of fire follows the written test.

Course Completion

There is a written test on the lesson material at the end of the course. The student will then go through a live fire qualification test. Upon successful completion of the course,

students will receive their certificates. Participants may also receive constructive suggestions and coaching during the live fire exercises.

Other Information and common questions:

Who may take this course? - Any person who is legally eligible to possess a pistol.

What is the level of the course? – The course is designed for the average pistol owner, however taking an NRA Basic Pistol Course beforehand is helpful.

Do I need to own a pistol to take this course? – Yes. You need to bring your own pistol (no .22 cal pistols, single action pistols or target type pistols. The pistol you bring to qualify with should be of the same type you would carry concealed for self-protection.) Also bring 2-3 magazines or speed loaders, a holster and 100 rounds of ammo.

Make sure your gun is unloaded and in a case. Please remember, no live ammo is allowed in the classroom so you are requested to leave your ammo in your vehicle.

Do I need to bring eye and ear protection to this course? – Yes.

(However, if you need them, some will be available for purchase.)

Does this course have a textbook? - Yes.

The handbook *Concealed Carry handgun Training* will be provided to each student.
