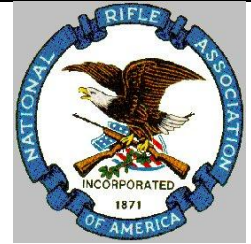




SIR WALTER GUN CLUB

2011 HIGH POWER COMPETITION SCHEDULE



Dates:	Registration begins at 8:00 am. All matches will begin at 9:00 am See Individual Match Bulletin for specific detail and rules.
Saturday, 26 Feb.	Vintage Rifle Match, 30 Rounds + 5 sighters, CMP Sanctioned
Saturday, 26 Mar.	500 Aggregate, NRA Sanctioned
Saturday, 23 Apr.	800 Aggregate, 4-Man Teams only for team matches, NRA Sanctioned
Sunday, 24 Apr.	500 Aggregate, 4-Man Teams only for team matches, NRA Sanctioned
Saturday, 25 June	500 Aggregate, NRA Sanctioned
Saturday, 27 Aug.	500 Aggregate, NRA Sanctioned
Saturday, 24 Sept.	Garand Clinic + 30 rounds Practice, CMP Sanctioned
Saturday, 8 Oct.	Garand Match, As Issued, 30 rounds + sighters CMP Sanctioned

Eligibility:	Match is open to the public and all interested competitors.
Rules:	Current NRA rules will govern, and competitors will adhere to SWGC safety policies. Open Bolt indicators will be used; a small supply is available from the match director. Competitors will hang and score targets. Bring Staple guns.
Equipment:	Standard issue service rifles or foreign service rifles having not less than 4.5 lb. trigger pull may be used. NRA Match rifles may be used, however will be placed in separate category. Metallic sights only. A limited number of M-1 Garand rifles will be available at no additional cost for competitor use, requested in advance. Must use as issued ammo. Club rifles will be properly cleaned by the competitor prior to turn-in after the match.
Course of fire:	All matches will be fired at 100 yards. A sighting in period will be allowed prior to each match. 30 rounds for vintage rifle match and Garand match, consisting of 10-prone slow, in ten minutes; 10-prone rapid fire in 70 seconds; and 10 slow fire offhand in ten minutes. (SR-1 Targets will be used). 500 Agg. Will consist of 10 rounds Standing in ten minutes, 10 rounds rapid sitting in 60 seconds, 10 rounds prone rapid fire in 70 seconds, and 20 rounds prone slow fire in 20 minutes. (SR-1, SR-1, SR-21, and MR-31 Targets will be used). 800 Agg. Will consist of 20 rounds in each position, Standing 20 minutes, sitting rapid fire-60 seconds each sequence, prone rapid fire-70 seconds each sequence, and prone slow fire 20 minutes. (SR-1, SR-1, SR-21, and MR-31 Targets will be used).
Match within a Match:	To encourage HP rifle competition, Sir Walter Gun Club will allow competitors with any HP rifle to compete under the NRA rules. Any safe to fire, center-fire rifle may be used with any sights, no Class III weapons. Sporter Rifle allows matches of 32 or 40 rounds: equal # of shots are fired in each position, ie. 8-8-8-8 or 10-10-10-10
Awards:	NRA points are be distributed according to standings in the Grand Aggregate. Classes may be combined for award purposes if there are less than 5 competitors in a class.
Entry Limit:	Entries will be accepted up to range capacity of 40, there are 20 firing points.
Entry Fee:	SWGC Member, Seniors =55 y.o and match directors \$10 , Non-Member \$15, Juniors \$5.00 (covers NRA fee of \$4.50 and targets). Make checks payable to SWGC.
