<u>Date:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Saturday, February 25, 2012 - 9:00 a.m. CMP Approved 30 round Match ➤ Registration will start 08:00 a.m. on Range 4
<u>Location:</u>	Sir Walter Gun Club, Range 4, Creedmoor, N. C. Take U.S. 15 for 3.5 miles north of Creedmoor, turn right on SR 1129 (Hester Road), range is 1/2 mile east of U.S. 15 on left. (See map and match info on website). http://www.sirwaltergunclub.com/
<u>Eligibility:</u>	Match is open to the public and to all interested competitors. CMP Liability forms may be notarized ahead of time and sent with pre registration or brought to clinic or match. Club liability forms will be available on site or downloaded from the SWGC website and either mailed or brought with you.
<u>Class:</u>	NRA classification system will be used. Unclassified shooters will fire in the Master Class or may use a classification if held in either small bore or international rifle categories.
<u>Rules:</u>	We will use the NRA component for the rapid fire sequences, starting the respective matches in the sitting and prone positions. (We are using the safest sequences for rapid fire; this is a blend of the CMP & NRA rules). Competitors will hang and score targets. All rifles must have an open bolt indicator and will be available at a charge to competitors. Competitors will fire an "As-Issued Military Rifle only" as defined in the CMP Competition Rules Sec 6.3. See CMP website for details. (http://www.odcmp.com/competitions.htm)
<u>Equipment:</u>	As-issued Military Rifles US (all of Sec 6.3) and Foreign Rifles (bolt rifles only Sec 6.3.6), excluding the M14 & M16-AR15 class of rifles (Sec 6.2.2-3). Match Rifles will not scored or allowed to compete in this event. Metallic sights only. There are <u>eight</u> M1 Garands owned by SWGC that will be available at no additional cost for competitor use, but must be reserved in advance. CMP .30-06 ammunition will be available for Club rifles only. Please contact us in advance if you will need to borrow a rifle for the match. All other equipment must be provided by the competitor. Staple guns are required. All Club rifles must be properly cleaned prior to turn-in. Hearing and Eye protection are required on all SWGC ranges.
<u>Course of Fire:</u>	All matches will be fired at 100 yards for a total of 30 scored rounds. SR-1 Target for all Matches. There will be a 5 minute unlimited sighter period before the match; taken from any position. We will over ride the first round for each of the rapid fire sequences. Match 1: 10 shots slow fire prone, 10 minute time limit. Match 2: 10 shots rapid fire, starting in standing go to the prone position 80 seconds time limit. Match 3: 10 shots slow fire Standing, 10 minute time limit. Match 4: Grand Aggregate - Total of Matches 1, 2, 3.
<u>Awards:</u>	CMP award pins will be given in each class in the Grand Aggregate. Classes may be combined for award purposes if there are less than 3 competitors entered in a class.
<u>Lunch</u>	Competitors will need to bring their own lunch for this event

Entry Limit: Post entries will be accepted up to the capacity of this Match (40), Pre-Registration is encouraged. Those sending their entries in by Friday February 24th, will be entered into an early registration raffle.

Entry Fee: Entry fee includes CMP Match Fee and CMP .30-'06 M2 Ball ammunition (35 rounds – loose) to used for the Match
