<b>Dates:</b>	Registration begins at 8:00 am. All matches will begin at 9:00 am See each individual Match Bulletin for specific details and rules.		
Saturday, 25 Feb.	Vintage Rifle Match, 30 Rounds + 5 sighters, CMP Sanctioned		
Saturday, 24 Mar.	High Power Rifle, 500 Aggregate, NRA Approved		
Saturday, 28 Apr.	High Power Rifle, 500 Aggregate, NRA Approved		
Saturday, 23 June	High Power Rifle, 500 Aggregate, NRA Approved		
Saturday, 25 Aug.	High Power Rifle, 500 Aggregate, NRA Approved		
Saturday, 22 Sept.	M1 Garand / High Power Rifle Clinic + 30 rounds Practice, CMP Sanctioned		
Saturday, 27 Oct.	M1 Garand Match, As Issued, 30 rounds + 5 sighters, CMP Sanctioned		
<b>Eligibility:</b> Matches are open to the public and all interested competitors.			
<b>Rules:</b>	Current NRA or CMP rules will govern. Competitors will adhere to SWGC safety policies. Open Bolt indicators will be used; a small supply is available from the Match Director. Competitors will hang and score targets. Bring Staple guns.		
<b>Equipment:</b>	As Issued Service Rifles or foreign Service Rifles having not less than 4.5 lb. trigger pull may be used. NRA Match Rifles may be used, however will be placed in separate category. Metallic sights only. A limited number of M-1 Garand rifles will be available at no additional cost for competitor use, requested in advance, and must use Club ammo. Club rifles will be properly cleaned by the competitor prior to turn-in after the match.		
<b>Course of fire:</b>	All matches will be fired at 100 yards. A sighting in period will be allowed prior to each match. 30 rounds for vintage rifle match and Garand match, consisting of 10-Prone Slow Fire, in ten minutes; 10-Prone Rapid Fire in 70 seconds; and 10-Standing Slow Fire in ten minutes. (SR-1 Targets will be used). 500 Aggregate will consist of 10 rounds Standing Slow Fire in ten minutes, 10 rounds Rapid Sitting in 60 seconds, 10 rounds Prone Rapid Fire in 70 seconds, and 20 rounds Prone Slow Fire in 20 minutes. (SR-1, SR-1, SR-21, and MR-31 Targets will be used).		
<b>Match within a Match:</b>	To encourage HP rifle competition, Sir Walter Gun Club will allow competitors with any HP rifle to compete under the NRA rules. Any safe to fire, center-fire rifle may be used with any sights, no Class III weapons. Sporter Rifle allows matches of 32 or 40 rounds: equal # of shots are fired in each position, i.e. 8-8-8-8 or 10-10-10-10		
<b>Awards:</b>	NRA points will be distributed according to standings in the Grand Aggregate. Classes may be combined for award purposes if there are less than 5 competitors in a class.		
<b>Entry Limit:</b>	Entries will be accepted up to range capacity of 48, there are 24 firing points.		
<b>Entry Fee:</b>	SWGC Members, Seniors =55 y.o and visiting Match Directors \$15 , Non-Member \$20, Juniors \$5.00 (covers NRA fee of \$4.50 and targets). Make checks payable to SWGC. See on-line Registration Form for required information.
